Hi Marty – I believe the Northeast Region Board had your quarterly meeting since we last communicated. At that meeting were you able to discuss the potential of a bi-region conference with the CSI Middle Atlantic Region for 2023?

I was unable to attend the board meeting personally so don't have a full board yeah or nay. Our discussions have generally been that it's a positive idea and there is little downside so let's continue to examine the details and see if we can make it work.

If it is something you'd still like to explore, could we have a Zoom meeting on Tuesday, 11/30 (or another date if more convenient for you) to discuss details about a bi-region conference. We are open to the idea, but have several questions about how this would work, including:

1. For 2023 is the NJ Chapter hosting the Northeast Region Conference, or was the region itself hosting it?

The way we structure it is the region takes on the contracts and the financial responsibility.

Our host chapters identify potential locations, conference technical theme, technical program presenters, attractions/guest program potential, banquet entertainment, giveaway themes.

Region identifies leadership programs and presenters, institute update and region forum/meeting. Both region and chapter promote sponsorships.

Region provides handling of registration and administrative tasks.

Host chapter provides volunteer labor at event itself.

2. I believe you had mentioned a venue had been identified in NJ to hold it in 2023. Can you confirm that and where it is?

We're planning to be in Jersey City. We started negotiations with two hotels there that would both have no problem handling the additional attendance.

3. Who would "take the lead" in planning this event, or would it be a joint effort between the two regions? We could certainly help organize some of the educational sessions as well as promote the event.

My opinion - the easiest way to move forward for us is to continue the way we would do it ourselves and supplement the event with any Mid-Atlantic specific requirements / extra sessions / and we both promote it as a joint event to take advantage of having additional attendees and additional potential sponsors. Additional volunteers to serve on the committee to identify worthwhile presenters and topics would be welcome.

4. Regarding finances, if profit was made from this event, how would that be shared (perhaps a percentage based upon the number of attendees from each region)?

My opinion - I think this would be a good way to approach it. Note - we run the conference with a break even target. When we successfully market the event and bring in more money from sponsors and participation, we spend it on the attendees to improve the experience. Our Region policy is then to split any leftover profit with the host chapter and we could adjust that to make a three way split based on MAR participation.

5. Have you ever done a bi-region CSI conference before (I had attended one many years ago between our region and the Southeast region, and it was held in Charlotte, but I didn't have anything to do with planning it)?

We haven't. Over the years we've discussed it at times but the added travel has always been the negative that made the board reject the idea - just like I'm sure your board would have a problem with my asking your members to all drive up to Maine or Vermont. Doing this in a year when we're planning to be in our southernmost location on the edge of your region makes a lot of sense.

Originally, our Richmond, VA chapter was going to host the 2023 Middle Atlantic Region conference. They have not yet secured a venue or set up any tours/educational programming. They might be agreeable to moving their conference to 2024, with our region board helping in the planning of a bi-region conference in NJ in 2023.

I would like our region executive committee members, as well as a few other region members involved in our region conferences, to be on a Zoom meeting with you and your committee members, to explore the bi-region conference possibility.

December 13th or 14th would be better for me. I'll check with other from this end and see if there is a preferred date/time.
